My second string quartet begins with a *Fanfare* built from the opening three measures. These three measures contain a little theme of six eighth-notes, two dotted quarter-notes, and a dotted half-note. The thirty-eight measure *Fanfare* develops the theme in various ways in about a minute's time.

Reflection is a yearning, ascending, impressionistic movement inspired by the slow movement of Debussy's string quartet. The *Danse Rêve* (dream dance) that follows is a romantic slow-waltz which I liked so much I used it again in my *Variants for Flute & Guitar and Strings*. The concluding movement is a reverse series of eight *Variations* succeeded by a return of the theme from the *Fanfare* — the basis for the set of variations.
